Grafting

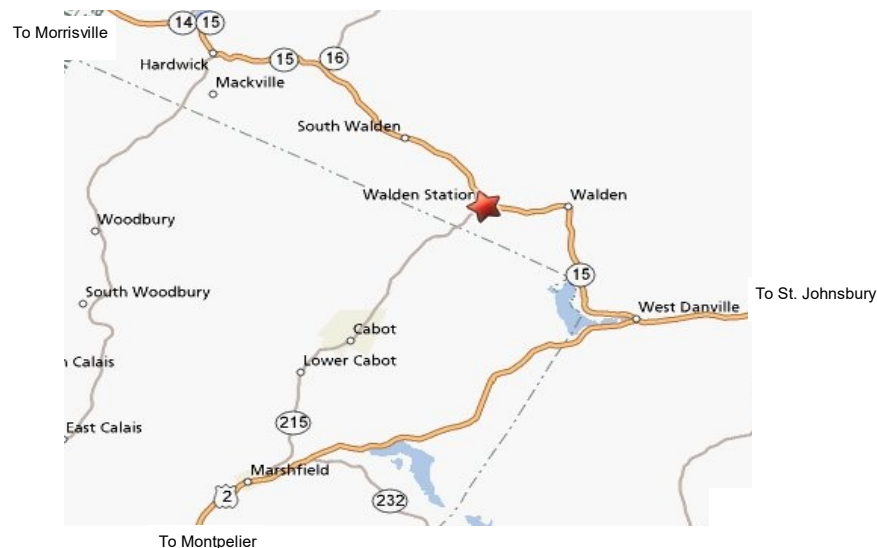

Apple Cultivars

\$45—75

All of our apple trees are organically grown and hand-grafted onto extremely hardy seedling rootstocks, which will withstand temperatures of -40° and colder. This standard rootstock often means a large, prolific, and long-lived tree. A standard tree can live well over one hundred years and provide 10 to 30 bushels of fruit a year at maturity. Dwarf trees sold in many nurseries and catalogues may languish in this climate or die outright. *Please check our website for current availability.*
